Multiple Product Installation Guide



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Multiple Product Installation

The BindView RMS® Multiple Product Installation (MPI) utility allows you to set up a group of BindView RMS bv-Control® v8.0 or later products in a local or network folder and then install all the items to a machine using a single set of installation options. When you run the Multiple Product Installation Utility, the only a single set of installation option prompts appear. This makes installation and upgrading of your bv-Control products simpler and faster.

The Multiple Product Installation Utility automates only the installation process. After the installation is complete, you must still configure the BindView RMS Console and any BindView RMS Snap-ins you have installed using the BindView RMS Console configuration wizard and any snap-in configuration routines. For information on configuring your products, please see each product's individual user guide.

Using the Multiple Product Installation Utility, you can install the BindView RMS Console and one or more bv-Control products to a machine which does not have BindView RMS products installed. In addition, you can use the Multiple Product Installer Utility to upgrade the BindView RMS Console and any installed bv-Control products. Alternately, if the machine has the BindView RMS Console v8.00 or later installed, you can install or upgrade multiple bv-Control products without installing the BindView RMS Console.

Requirements

In order to use the Multiple Product Installation Utility, you must have the BindView RMS Console v8.00 or later and one or more bv-Control v8.00 or later products. In addition, you must have sufficient space in a local or network folder to store copies of the installation files for the products you will be installing. The amount of space required depends on exactly which products you will install. Finally, the machine where you will install the bv-Control products must meet the requirements for all of the bv-Control products you will install. Please see each product's individual user guide for information on requirements.

Using the Multiple Product Installation Utility

1 Installation files the Multiple Product Installation Utility will use must be copied to a local or network folder. Select or create a folder on your hard disk or network to use for the Multiple Product Installation files. The folder you choose must be able to accommodate all installation files from the BindView RMS products you add.



2 Insert the BindView RMS Console and Information Server CD. The Multiple Product Installation utility is located on this CD. The BindView Install Panel appears.

- 3 Click Browse CD. The Windows® Explorer appears.
- **4** Open the **MPI** folder on the CD.
- 5 Choose Edit > Select All (or press Ctrl-A).
- 6 Choose **Edit > Copy** (or press Ctrl-C).

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- 7 Open the local or network folder you will run the installation procedure from and choose **Edit > Paste** (or press Ctrl-V). The Multiple Product Installation Utility will be copied into the folder.
- 8 Copy the **MSDE** folder from the BindView RMS Console and Information Server CD to the Multiple Product Installation folder.
- **9** The installation files for the products you will install must now be copied to the folder you chose. For each BindView RMS product you will install (including the BindView RMS Console and Information Server), you should follow these steps:
 - Insert the product CD. The Install Panel will appear.
 - Click Browse CD.
 - Locate the folder with the product's name and select it. This is the product installation folder. For most products, this folder is at the top level (root) of the CD. For NETinventory, the \NETinventory\NETinventory RMS Snap-in folder is the product installation folder.
 - Copy the product installation folder to the Multiple Product Installation folder you chose.
 - Locate the Release Notes folder on the product CD and select it.
 - Copy the Release Notes folder to the Multiple Product Installation folder. On the second product and after, you will be prompted to replace files with the same name. When this happens, click **Yes to All**. The files being replaced are graphics used in the read me files.
 - Click the BindView Install Panel in the Windows Taskbar, then click the close box to exit.
 - Eject the product CD.
 - Repeat until all product installation folders have been copied.



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10 When all product installation folders have been copied, double-click the **Setup** program in the Multiple Product Installation folder. The **BindView Multi-Product Installation** panel appears.

- **11** Click **Install**. The **Select an Install Type** panel appears.
- **12** There are two install types, **Client Only** and **Full**. The Client-Only installation installs only components appropriate to the BindView RMS Console.

If you are installing on a machine that will host only the BindView RMS Console and the bv-Control products you have added to the Multiple Product Installation, click **Client Only Multi-Product Install**.

If you are installing on a machine that will host the BindView Information Server and the BindView RMS Console in addition to the bv-Control products you have added to the Multiple Product Installation, click **Full Multi-Product Install**.

The **Prerequisite Checklist** panel appears.

13 In order to install any BindView RMS products, your computer must meet certain minimum requirements.

If you have not installed them, you should install them now.

If you are certain that you have installed them and are ready to proceed, click **I** have satisfied all installation prerequisites and want to continue.

15 Read the license agreement and click **Yes** to accept the terms of the agreement.

If you are performing a Full installation, or if you are not installing the BindView RMS Console, skip to Step 16.

If you are installing a Client-Only install and you are installing the BindView RMS Console, the **Select Information Server** panel appears.

- **17** The **Start Copying Files** panel appears.

18 Review the **Current Settings** information and click **Next** to begin the installation.

The products you added are installed. If included, the BindView RMS Console and Information server are installed first, then any bv-Control products are installed in alphabetical order.

If the MSDE or Microsoft SQL Server installation that will be used by the Information Server is not properly secured, **BindView Security Alert** dialogs appear. If this happens, please consult the *BindView RMS Console and Information Server User Guide* for information on securing the server.

19 When the installation is complete, the **BindView RMS Console Setup Wizard** dialog appears.
